- Stephen from Crawfords, who supplies the kit will be in school each morning from **8.30 - 9.15 from Monday 23rd June - Friday 27 June**. Please aim to call in on any of those morning for **sizing and details on ordering**
- If your child is in P7 or has outgrown their current kit, please consider donating it as a pre-loved kit to be used by another child
- If finance/affordability is a barrier to purchasing the kit, please speak to me in confidence and we can sort something out.

P6 enjoyed taster sessions at Strathearn and Campbell College, getting a really valuable glimpse in to life at a Post Primary school.

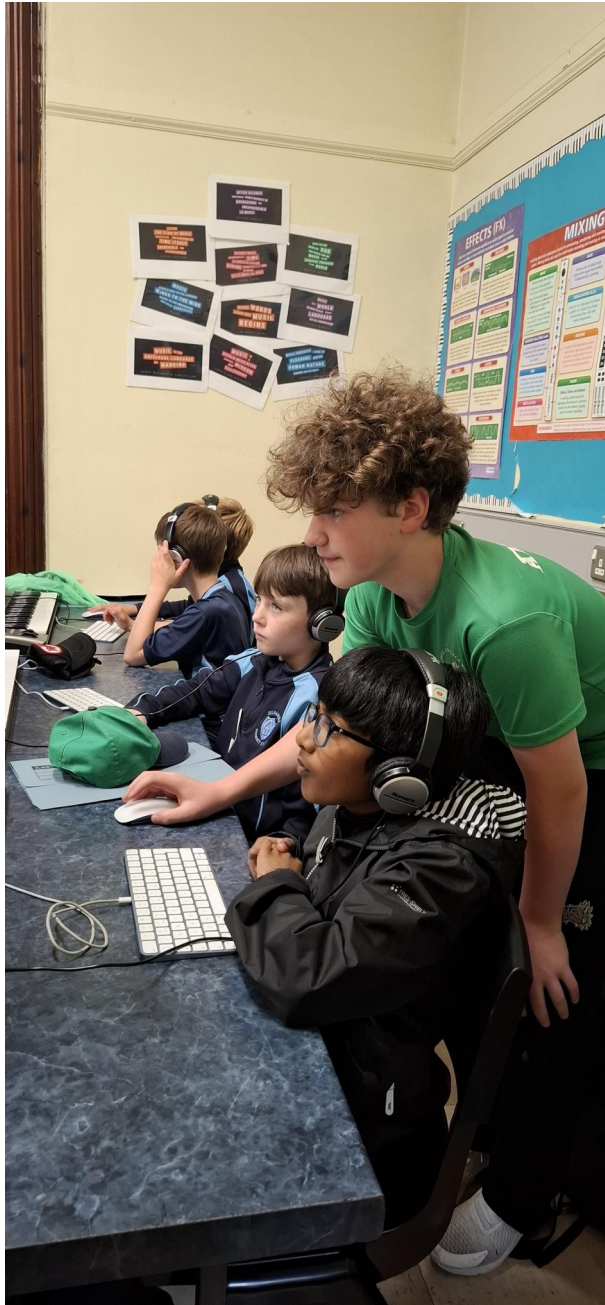
It was also lovely to meet three of our past pupils, who helped with the session - Isaac, Xander and Marshall.
